CHOOSING YOUR COURSE

Use the NewVlc prospectus to help you decide which course is most suitable for you. It may be useful to discuss your options with your teacher, Connexions adviser, friends and family. NewVlc is a popular choice for thousands of students and we therefore recommend that you submit your application as early as possible.

During the first few weeks of term, teachers and support staff from NewVlc will visit your school to offer advice about completing the application form. In the meantime, here is an explanation of the application process.

OPEN DAY

We strongly advise you to attend one of our two open days. These offer an opportunity to talk to teachers and students about the different courses available and look at the facilities.

COMPLETE AN APPLICATION FORM

You can get an application from school or request one from the college. Take your time completing the form to make sure you have provided all the information we need. You will need to ask your teacher to provide a reference on the back of the form before it is sent to the college.

ATTEND AN INTERVIEW

Once your application has been processed you will be invited to attend an interview with your progress file, record of achievement and samples of work. This is an opportunity for us to establish whether you are suited for the course you have applied for. It is also an opportunity for you to speak to the teachers about your application so that you are confident that you are making a good choice.

TASTER DAY

If you have accepted a conditional offer you will be invited to come and experience a day in the life of a NewVlc student. This will take place during the summer term and will be an opportunity for you to try out your chosen subjects and courses and find out about the clubs and activities run at NewVlc.

ENROLMENT

We will write to you to let you know when you should enrol. You will need to bring all your GCSE results along to enrolment.

We hope that you achieve your target grades and can enrol on your first choice of course. However, if you do not achieve the grades stated on your conditional offer you can still attend enrolment and we will advise you on the options open to you.
